- Other similar tasks, as requested

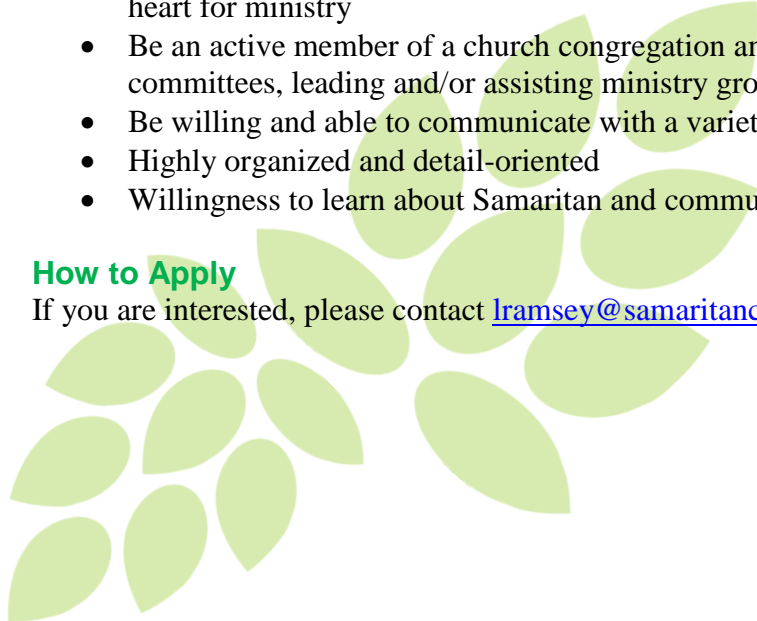


### Skills/Qualifications
